Marshals' Instructions

1. Thank you for volunteering to marshal at this event which is part of the two day Brooklands Double Twelve Motorsport Festival. Marshals' parking will be in free of charge public car park 'The Heights' for this event, please follow the AA/RAC signs, park and bring all of your equipment with you.

Senior Officials, Rescue and Medical teams and Marshals whose roles require then to have their cars in the paddock will find enclosed a Paddock Pass, you should follow the brown signs directing you to Mercedes-Benz World; please refer to the enclosed map.

3. The Marshals' allocations are as on the attached sheet but may be revised according to needs on the day. The signing-on base will be, as in previous years, on the grass between the paddock and the track as shown on the enclosed map. There will be a Marshals' briefing at 0915hrs on the start line or as advised at signing-on.

4. There will be a lunch break, which will be as long as possible, but please understand that it may be necessary to shorten the break due to practice delays, etc. All marshals will be issued with a packed lunch courtesy of Brooklands Museum. Collection will be from where you signed-on.

5. Marshals should prepare themselves for all weathers; sun protection if the weather is as good; suitable waterproofs if the forecast is not so good. The venue is very open with no shelter from the elements.

6. Please note it is a specific MSA instruction that armbands must only be issued to persons appointed to act in an official capacity, and that such armbands are not transferable. The armband issued to you when you sign-on is for your use in connection with the duty allocated to you only - it must not be lent or passed to any other person, or be used for gaining access to any prohibited area.

7. Motor Sport can be dangerous, and marshals should stand no nearer to the edge of the track than is absolutely necessary for the performance of their duties and where possible behind the protective barriers. If your duty is in an area which is prohibited to the public, please note that you are not authorised to allow friends or relations to enter these areas, and you should ask anyone present who is not authorised to be there to leave. Remember that the Club has the use of the site on the understanding that spectators are confined to the public strays beyond these areas. Marshals must not carry cameras - if you are off duty and wish to take photographs, for instance during the lunch break, please remove your armband before doing so. Marshals and officials should abstain from the consumption of alcohol or drugs while on duty. Any marshal under the age of 18 must sign-on using an Under 18's signing-on sheet with parental/guardian consent in writing.

8. ALCOHOL BREATHALYSER TEST

22.1 In accordance with D13.1.4, all Drivers and Officials consent to submit themselves to a alcohol breathalyser test as required.

22.2 The Club approved equipment used for testing are 'AlcoSense Ultra' breathalysers within valid calibration periods of their current calibration certificates. Calibration and maintenance of the devices will be undertaken by AlcoSense Breathalysers.

- 22.3 A Driver or Official who is considered to be possibly unfit due to consumption of alcohol will not be permitted to participate. Such persons may request a re-test after a period of at least 60 mins.
- 22.4 If the Driver or Official is still considered unfit following the second test he/she remains ineligible to participate.
- 22.5 Should a Driver not participate in either qualifying or a race / timed run due to the possibility of being unfit due the consumption of alcohol, further participation shall be at the sole discretion of the Clerk of Course.
- 22.6 In addition to the test, the Clerk of the Course and/or the Secretary of the Meeting may, at their sole discretion, direct that a test be carried out on any Driver or Official at any time during the meeting should they consider there are grounds for doing so.
- 22.7 The results of all breathalyser tests remain confidential between the Secretary of the Meeting, the Clerk of the Course and the Driver or Official concerned.
- 22.8 Refusal or withdrawal of consent to take a breathalyser test will be treated as a failure of the test and the Driver or Official shall be excluded from participation at the meeting.
