Please note signing-on is in practice order. Do not arrive early as you will delay those who have to practice before you do and you will be politely asked to return at your allotted time.

Entry to the paddock is from 16.30 on Thursday 4 August. Numbered markers will be placed in the paddock to show your parking space which will be the same as your competition number. The paddock plan will be displayed in various locations in the paddock and at the entrances as well as event Officials on hand to direct you to the right location. Competitors who also have an entry for the Saturday/Sunday event should be aware that they will have to move paddock location following Friday's competition to that of their weekend number. Trailers must be removed from the paddock and left in the trailer field. Motor-homes and transporters must be removed from the paddock and left in the camping field. The following drivers have been granted a transporter pitch: J. Wilton, N.Topliss. These pitches will be set out on the wide verge backing onto the main road at the bottom of the paddock.

4. SIGNING-ON & SCRUTINEERING (which, like practice, is in Class order - refer to the timetable above)

Remember your licence and sign-on in the marquee adjacent to the main pedestrian entrance behind the venue offices. At signing-on you will be given a ticket which you will give to the scrutineer. Return to your car, affix your competition numbers to the car and wait for the scrutineer to come to you in your allotted paddock space. Once satisfied with your car and equipment the scrutineer will issue you with a sticker which you attach to your car.

5. WALKING THE COURSE

All competitors have the opportunity to walk the course taking note of the features and the location of Marshals' posts. This must be completed by 09.30 at which point practice runs will start. Remember this event uses the full course INCLUDING THE LOOP EXTENSION.

6. PADDOCK SAFETY

The push start area will be in the bottom paddock and will be well sign-posted and permanently marshalled. Inform the Marshals of your intention and wait for their signal before proceeding.

Any cars that have their driven wheels spinning whilst warming up must have safety guards around these wheels and have their stationary wheels chocked. Whilst this is taking place a responsible person, able to take immediate action, must be seated in the driving seat.

The paddock will be a very busy place throughout the day and great care must be taken at all times when moving from place to place. Practising starts on the paddock roads is dangerous and strictly forbidden.

7. PRACTICE RUNS (MORNING) & TIMED RUNS (AFTERNOON)

SHARED CARS – The lower numbered driver will run within their Class. The higher numbered driver will run in a batch at END OF THE MORNING RUNS AFTER CLASS16 and FIRST RUNS AFTER THE LUNCH-BREAK PRIOR TO CLASS 1. All other Classes will run in numerical order by car number.

Listen carefully to the paddock announcements and be ready to move to the assembly area when your Class is called to do so. Be aware of which Class are on the hill to ensure you are in the right place at the right time. Once in the assembly area do not leave your car. Follow the Marshals' instructions and proceed through the paddock gate to the tyre warming area and then onto the start line. On completion of your runs slow down and turn left into the return road and proceed with extreme caution and at slow speed to the paddock. This road is a public bridleway; if you encounter horses or pedestrians you must stop and give way to them.

8. HANDICAPS

These are shown in the enclosed entry lists. Any changes made as a result of practice times will be published on the official notice board during the lunch break before the timed runs start.

9. CLEARING THE PADDOCK

The Saturday/Sunday event has over 250 entrants who will have access to the paddock from 18.30 on Friday. To ensure an efficient changeover and to minimise disruption it will be necessary for all cars to leave the paddock by 18.00 or for those also competing at the weekend event to relocate to their weekend paddock space.

10. NON-STARTS

11. NOISE MONITORING - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

All cars must be silenced in accordance with the MSA Regulations: MSA Regulations in respect of noise testing apply; additionally any driver/vehicle combination exceeding a reading of 109 dB(A) on the drive by noise monitoring system will result in the time recorded on that run being disallowed and any driver/vehicle combination breaching the drive by limit on two occasions will be excluded from the meeting without further participation. The MSA Environmental Scrutineer is T Jones who is deemed a Judge of Fact, (G)7.9.5 applies; the noise monitoring equipment is situated between the start line and pedestrian bridge on the left hand side adjacent to the Clubhouse.

You are cordially invited to a small Awards Ceremony outside the Clubhouse on Friday evening 30 minutes after the last competitive run on the hill.

Please support the Prescott Bicycle Races, sponsored by Merry Printers (Sunday 9.00am)




