YOUR WRISTBAND FOR THE EVENT HAS BEEN POSTED TO YOU, THIS IS YOUR ENTRY PASS!

Payment will be expected, on either day, from anyone not wearing their wristband.

Please park in the Orchard car park, a parking pass has been posted to you. Park along from the Bugatti Trust building adjacent to the road. We are very keen to have the minimum number of modern cars parked on the track verge adjacent to the start-line. Please be assured that all officials, marshals and volunteers are greatly appreciated and the parking arrangements are solely to present the best period image possible at this event which is a showcase for the Club. Some Senior Officials and all emergency personnel have passes allowing their vehicles into the paddock side of Prescott. Please have your wristbands and parking passes ready in advance of arriving to prevent congestion at the entrance.

Clothing

Marshals should dress appropriately for their duty. Those working trackside, or otherwise closely with competing cars should note that shorts and short sleeve shirts are not acceptable. Please observe the usual standards of behaviour expected of Marshals at speed events, do not allow friends to enter prohibited areas, do not stand with your back to approaching cars and do not take photographs while on duty. It is the responsibility of all Marshals to ensure that spectators do not get into prohibited areas or on to the track. Please remain at your post until cleared to stand down by the Clerk of the Course or his Deputies. Marshals doing a stint of gate duty at the bottom of the hill should not leave the gate unattended at any time.

Alcohol Breathalyser Test

In accordance with D13.1.4, all Drivers and Officials consent to submit themselves to a alcohol breathalyser test as required.

The Club approved equipment used for testing are 'AlcoSense Ultra' breathalysers within valid calibration periods of their current calibration certificates. Calibration and maintenance of the devices will be undertaken by AlcoSense Breathalysers.

A Driver or Official who is considered to be possibly unfit due to consumption of alcohol will not be permitted to participate. Such persons may request a re-test after a period of at least 60 mins.

If the Driver or Official is still considered unfit following the second test he/she remains ineligible to participate.

Should a Driver not participate in either qualifying or a race / timed run due to the possibility of being unfit due the consumption of alcohol, further participation shall be at the sole discretion of the Clerk of Course.

In addition to the test, the Clerk of the Course and/or the Secretary of the Meeting may, at their sole discretion, direct that a test be carried out on any Driver or Official at any time during the meeting should they consider there are grounds for doing so.

The results of all breathalyser tests remain confidential between the Secretary of the Meeting, the Clerk of the Course and the Driver or Official concerned.

Refusal or withdrawal of consent to take a breathalyser test will be treated as a failure of the test and the Driver or Official shall be excluded from participation at the meeting.
