COMPETITORS' INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for entering the VSCC Loton Park Hill Climb. Your entry tickets are enclosed along with the Official Entry List & Safety Guidance Notes. A paddock plan will be sent to you by post or email in advance of the event. Loton Park is 8½ miles west of Shrewsbury; approached by A458 and then B4393. Please read these instructions to help with the smooth running of the weekend.

3. PADDOCK

Event ends

Entry to the paddock is from 18.00hrs on Friday 9 September. As stated above, a paddock plan will be sent to you in advance of the event. Do not swap paddock spaces with other competitors to be close to friends. The Senior Officials and Scrutineers will expect you to be in your allocated space. All tender vehicles and trailers must be removed from the paddock. Please do not park on the roadways, this simply causes congestion. Please note that there is no fuel available at the venue.

4. SIGNING-ON & SCRUTINEERING (please adhere to the order detailed in the timetable to prevent delaying those who run before you do) Remember your licence and sign-on in the VSCC 'marquee' which will be in the paddock towards the start line. At signing-on you will be given a coloured ticket which you should give to the scrutineer. Return to your car, affix your competition numbers to the car and wait for the scrutineer to come to you in your allotted paddock space. Competition numbers must be clearly legible on both sides of the car. MSA compliant numbers will be available at signing-on for £3 per set. In the event of adverse weather or upon the instruction of the Chief Scrutineer or Clerk of the Course these compliant numbers must be used by all competitors. Once satisfied with your car and equipment (including flame resistant gloves, which are mandatory) the scrutineer will issue you with a sticker which you attach to your car. Please ensure you bring your laminated VSCC Buff Passport with you for eligibility scrutineering.

5. NOISE TESTING

All cars must be silenced in accordance with MSA Regulations: J5.17.1, J5.17.2, J5.17.7 and J517.8. Static noise testing will take place, where a maximum reading at 2/3 maximum revs allowed is 108dBa for all cars when measured at 0.5m from the tailpipe at an angle of 45 degrees and at a height of 0.5m above the ground. Where more than one exhaust outlet is present the test will be repeated for each exhaust and the highest reading will be used. Where the exhaust outlet is not accessible the test may be conducted in line with MSA Regulations: J5.18.3.

6. WALKING THE COURSE

All competitors have the opportunity to walk or cycle the course taking note of the features and the location of Marshals' Posts. This must be completed by 09.30hrs on Saturday morning, at which point practice runs will start. Please be aware of any Officials' vehicles that may be on the course travelling in both directions.

7. PADDOCK SAFETY

Tow and Push Starting is only permitted in the designated area. Inform the marshals of your intention and wait for their signal before proceeding.

Any cars that have their driven wheels spinning while warming up must have safety guards around these wheels and have their stationary wheels chocked. While this is taking place the car must be under constant supervision by a person suitable to take any appropriate action situated in the driver's seat. The paddock will be a very busy place throughout the weekend and great care must be taken at all times when moving from place to place. Practicing starts on the paddock roads is dangerous and strictly forbidden.

8. PRACTICE RUNS (SATURDAY) & TIMED RUNS (SUNDAY)

Cars will run in Class order, please note:

SHARED CARS – The lower numbered driver will run within their Class. The higher numbered driver, will run in a batch at END OF THE MORNING RUNS, and FIRST RUNS AFTER THE LUNCH BREAK.

Listen carefully to the paddock announcements and be ready to move to the assembly area when your Class is called to do so. Be aware of which Class is on the Hill to ensure you are in the right place at the right time. Once in the Assembly Area do not leave your car. Follow the Marshals' instructions to the tyre warming area and then onto the start line.

On completion of your run slow down and follow the road to the top holding paddock, and wait for instructions from the Marshals to proceed, with extreme caution and at slow speed, back down the hill to the paddock. Helmets and gloves must be worn and a wave to the Marshals is always appreciated. All competition cars may be subject to post run scrutineering and may be held under Parc Ferme conditions until released by the Chief Scrutineer, even if this is at their paddock location.

9. HANDICAPS

These are included in the attached entry list. Any changes made as a result of practice times will be published at the Official Notice Board before the timed runs start. The Official Notice Board will be within the timing screens' hut adjacent to the start line.

10. RED FLAGS

Should a red flag be displayed in front of you, STOP immediately and await instructions from the nearest Marshal before proceeding.

11. NON-STARTS & RETIREMENTS

If you find that you will be unable to participate please inform the Secretary of the Meeting as soon as possible; the number of the Club office is 01608 644777 ext 5, up to 1700 hrs on Thursday 8 Sept September, thereafter on the following mobile phone number 07767 404670. Should you retire from the event please inform the Secretary of the Meeting in the Paddock Office.

12. COMPETITON NUMBERS & COMPETITION CARS ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY

All competitors should note that once a car has been scrutineered it cannot be driven on the public highway without being re-scrutineered. Likewise only road legal cars should be driven on the public highway at any time. Officials will be monitoring this and reporting offenders to the Clerk of the Course who can apply penalties. Competitors are reminded of MSA Regulation S9.2.6 – 'Competition numbers must be covered at all times whilst driving on the public highway', and should note that reprimands have been issued previously to competitors who have ignored this instruction.


13. CAMPING

Camping fees, £8.50 per pitch per night, will be collected on entry or on Friday and Saturday evening. Camping passes should be displayed on the side of the unit facing the access road. CAMPING IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE SUNDAY NIGHT.


If you have not purchased camping tickets on arrival, you must buy them at signing on or from the club van. Camp fires, ground barbeques and fireworks are strictly forbidden.

17. SATURDAY EVENING HOG ROAST


