1. Introduction

Thank you for volunteering to marshal at Snetterton Circuit. We greatly appreciate your assistance in making this, and all our other events, the successful meetings they are. Should you find for any reason that you are unable to attend, please contact the VSCC Competitions Department on 01608 644777 ext 4 up to 1000hrs on Thursday 14th September, or on the Events Mobile (07734 030999) thereafter.

2. Event Passes

If you have received these instructions by email, your entry tickets have been emailed to you directly by MSV separately. Those with no registered email with the Club, please find your entry ticket enclosed. Parking is free of charge.

3. Arrival and Signing-On

You will find below a table detailing of your required arrival time at signing-on and location details. When you sign-on you will be issued with a programme, armband or tabard, and a cash contribution towards your expenses. Marshals' names who do not appear on the marshalling list below should report to the Secretary of the Meeting for permission to sign-on. Any marshal under the age of 18 years must produce a letter of permission signed by a parent or guardian consenting to them assisting at the meeting.

4. Identification

Please ensure that you do not permit any other person to wear your allocated Marshal's armband, as only signed on personnel are permitted to wear official identification. If your duty is in an area that is prohibited to public access, you are not allowed to permit access to any non-signed on persons at any time. This includes any friends and/or family who may be attending the event.

5. Equipment

As your duty may require you to be outside all day, please ensure that you bring suitable clothing with you. Bottles of water will be available at signing-on.

6. Lunch Break

We will try to provide you with the longest lunch break as possible, but please be aware that this may have to be shortened should we suffer with delays during the morning practice sessions.

7. Health and Safety

We would like to remind you that motorsport can be dangerous, and that all safety features of the track and facilities should be made full use of at all times. Marshals should stand no closer to the track than absolutely necessary, and should use protective barrier whenever possible. You are also reminded that Marshals are not permitted to take photos or videos whilst on duty.

9. Alcohol Breathalyser Test

In accordance with D13.1.4, as a condition of participation, all Drivers and Officials consent to submit themselves to a random alcohol breathalyser test as required. The Club approved equipment used for testing will be 'AlcoSense Ultra' breathalysers within valid calibration periods of their current calibration certificates. Calibration and maintenance of the devices will be undertaken by AlcoSense Breathalysers. A Driver or Official who is considered to be possibly unfit due to consumption of alcohol will not be permitted to participate. Such persons may request a re-test after a period of at least 60 mins. If the Driver or Official is still considered unfit following the second test he/she remains ineligible to participate. Should a Driver not participate in either qualifying or a race / timed run due to the possibility of being unfit due to the consumption of alcohol, further participation shall be at the sole discretion of the Clerk of Course. In addition to the random test, the Clerk of the Course and/or the Secretary of the Meeting may, at their sole discretion, direct that a test be carried out on any Driver or Official at any time during the meeting should they consider there are grounds for doing so. The results of all breathalyser tests remain confidential between the Secretary of the Meeting, the Clerk of the Course and the Driver or Official concerned. Refusal or withdrawal of consent to take a breathalyser test will be treated as a failure of the test and the Driver or Official shall be excluded from participation at the meeting.
