### Give Ways

### 'White' roads

The whole rally route is on coloured roads with 3 exceptions. In the first half there is one short stretch (approx 100m) of 'white' road and in the second half there are two stretches of smooth 'white' road used that total approx. 2miles.

Each section of instructions starts with a whimsical title that relates to the section but is not part of the information required. However, at the end of the title are some letters in brackets:-

(CRO) = Coloured roads only. There are NO 'white' roads in these sections

(AR) = All roads. These sections include 'white' roads. Only the 'white' roads to be used are included in the instructions.

One second half 'white' is private property – ignore the PRIVATE signs at the start and follow the route you have plotted. It will soon become apparent you are on the correct route.

In the first half the surface of a length of yellow road deteriorates into a stretch of bumpy, un-made road which is shown on the map as a piece of 'white' road. It is partly covered by a green dot showing a cycleway and is not easy to see on the map. It does not affect your route choice. For simplicity this section is shown in your instructions as (CRO).

# Section I: Escape from Leyland

In order for competitors to get away from the start easily and not get lost in Leyland town centre Section 1 of your instructions is given as simple Turn Left (TL), Turn Right (TR) instructions. These can be plotted on your map or read directly to the driver at the start (or a mixture of each), whichever you prefer. The section ends with TC1 at 537195 which is in the car park of the PH, 2.2 miles from the start. An average speed of 13mph has been set for this section which equates to 10 minutes.

There will be no penalty for early arrival at TCI, so competitors can park up and wait for the correct time before leaving TCI.

The instructions for the second section start with TC9. All other TCs are undisclosed.

2) Bits 'n' Bobs (CRO)

In Order use 0.3 miles of Red road, a bridge over a canal, left at a roundabout onto a dual carriageway green road, then 1<sup>st</sup> right after 0.2 miles, then 4 YYY junctions to 400033

3) The Angle of Dangle (CRO)

Note the 'approach from' and 'depart to' directions


