




Supplementary Regulations

- 1. **Announcement**. The Vintage Sports-Car Club will organise a Touring Assembly on Sunday 9th June 2024, starting and finishing at **Buckland Park Lake**, **Park Lake Drive**, **Buckland**, **Betchworth**, **Surrey**, **RH3 7FE**.
- 2. **Regulations**. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) insofar as they apply to Touring Assemblies, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event. A Certificate of Exemption number will be obtained from Motorsport UK and will be displayed at the start.

- 4. **Vehicle eligibility**. The event is open to cars made before 1 January 1960 and driven by members of the Organising Club and the following invited clubs: the Allard Owners Club, Aston Martin Owners Club and the Triple-M Register. Cars do not need to have a VSCC 'Buff Form' eligibility document.
- 5. **Entering the Event**. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations and close on Sunday 2nd June. The maximum entry will be 40 cars, the minimum will be 10. The entry fee is £45 per car. Cheques to be made payable to VSCC Ltd. Please send a completed and signed entry form to: VSCC, Unit 1, Hockley Court, 2401 Stratford Road, Solihull, B94 6NW. - 6. **The Road Book**. Full Joining Instructions will be issued approximately one week prior to the event. A Road Book will be issued on the day, providing full and easy-to-follow navigational instructions and information about local places of interest.
- 7. **Registration**. On the Day Registration is from 09:00am until 10:30am, with cars leaving from 10:30am. Scrutineering is limited to ensuring the vehicle is eligible for the event. It is the entrant's responsibility to make sure their car is roadworthy. All cars must be insured for the public highway. It is recommended that all cars carry a serviceable fire extinguisher. All crew members must 'Sign On'. Anyone travelling in the car must be able to be properly seated in the car.
- 8. **Route**. The total distance covered will be approximately 80 miles. The start & finish location will be Buckland Park Lake, Park Lake Drive, Buckland, Betchworth, Surrey, RH3 7FE.
- 9. **Driving Standards**. Horses, cyclists, walkers and inconsiderate drivers can be expected at many places along the route. Do please give them the appropriate consideration. All drivers are reminded that they should abstain from the consumption of alcohol or drugs during the event.
- 10. **Lunch.** Participants are recommended to book lunch at one of three pubs (details of which can be found here) on the route, or to bring along a picnic lunch. Further details will be included in the Joining Instructions issued a week prior to the tour.
- 11. **Finish**. At the finish all drivers must report to the organisers to sign a Damage Declaration Form. Crews are expected to return to the start/finish from approx 3.30pm till no later than 5.00pm.
- 12. **Trailers.** There is room for cars and trailers at the start venue to be left at the owner's risk till 5:00pm.

SAFETY, HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT AND FIRE (SHEF) AT THE VINTAGE SPORTS-CAR CLUB (VSCC) AND DURING VSCC EVENTS

It is the Policy of the Vintage Sports-Car Club (the Club) to operate in a positive culture of safety, health, and environmental protection throughout its entire business and sporting activities. To this end, the Club will coordinate all relevant activities under the collective heading of Safety, Health, Environment and Fire, or 'SHEF'.

The Club fully recognises the potential risks in its activities, the application of relevant legislation, and that it has the ultimate legal responsibility in these matters both in the workplace and at the Club's events. Accordingly, the President accepts overall responsibility for policy formulation and effective implementation of that policy. In turn, all employees, competitors, officials, and volunteer helpers are responsible for all SHEF duties allocated to them, either directly, or as a result of the Club's SHEF policy. Members of the public at Club events, whether paying or not, will be advised of their responsibilities as a result of their decision to spectate.

In pursuance of this policy, the Club will progressively identify all hazards and take measures to reduce risk. Motor Sport is spectacular and exciting, providing enjoyment to competitors and spectators alike, but there are many aspects of the sport which carry inherent risk. Much of this risk cannot be eliminated totally, and the emphasis must therefore be placed on controlling the risk through effective risk management systems. The purpose of such Risk Management will be elimination of the risk where possible, or to reduce the risk to levels which are demonstrably As Low As Reasonably Practicable (ALARP) where it cannot.

Throughout all of its activities, the Club will appoint an appropriate number of competent persons to implement the Club's SHEF procedures. In addition, a number of SHEF committees are established to ensure proper consideration of all risk factors, Committee members and other competent persons may be employees or volunteers. Competence will be guaranteed by formal training, the maintenance of records and, for motor sports events, full compliance with the rules and regulations of Motorsport UK (MSUK), the governing body of the sport in the UK, and the venue owners.

damage can and do happen. I understand that these risks may give rise to my suffering personal injury or other loss and I acknowledge and accept these risks.

2) To the best of my belief the driver(s) possess(es) the standard of competence necessary for the Event to which this entry relates and that the vehicle entered conforms to the Regulations of the Event. Where applicable the use of the vehicle

hereby entered will be covered by insurance as required by law

3) I agree that should I at the time of this Event be suffering from any disability whether permanent or temporary which is likely to affect prejudicially my normal control of the vehicle, I may not take part unless I have declared such disability

to Motorsport UK which has, following such declaration, issued a licence which permits me to do so. I undertake that at the time of the Event to which this entry relates I shall have passed or am exempt from an ASN specified medical examination within the specified period. (H10.1.6)

4) If I am the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor of the driver I have countersigned the competitor licence application and understand that I shall have the right to be present during any procedure being carried out under the Event Supplementary

Regulations and the General Regulations and that I have acquainted myself and the minor with them, agree to pay any appropriate charges and fees pursuant to those Regulations and agree to be bound by and submit myself without reserve

to the consequences resulting from them (and any alteration thereof). Further, I agree to pay as liquidated damages any fines imposed upon me up to the maxima set out in Part 3, Appendix I.

Note: Where the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor will not be present the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor must advise the organisers in advance, in writing, authorising their appointed representative to so act.

5) I hereby agree to abide by all applicable Motorsport UK Policies and Guidelines including but not exclusively Safeguarding and Anti Alcohol and Drugs policies and the National Sporting Code of Conduct.

6) I have read and shall respect the regulations for Control of Drugs and Alcohol as contained in the General Regulations C1.1.7, D35.1, G15.1.4, H38 and have also fully familiarised myself with the information on the web sites referred to

(www.motorsportuk.org, www.ukad.org.uk and www.wada-ama.org) in particular the UK Anti-Doping Rules which have been adopted by Motorsport UK. Further, if I am counter-signing as the parent or Guardian of a minor then in addition to
