## **Supplementary Regulations**

- The Vintage Sports-Car Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans permit hill climb meeting Wiscombe Park Hill Climb Course, Wiscombe Park, Southleigh, Colyton, Devon, EX24 6JE on Sunday 13 May 2018.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), the General Speed Regulations of the VSCC, these Supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. MSA Permit Number: 104855
- 4. The meeting has been inscribed with the FIA as a NCAFP.
- The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and fully paid-up members of the 500 Owners' Association. The driver will be deemed to be the entrant in all instances, except where they have not reached their 18th birthday (H27.1.7 – H27.1.8).
- 6. An approximate programme for the meeting will be: -

0800hrs Scrutineering and Signing-on opens

0900hrs Practice commences

1030hrs Any competitor not scrutineered or signed-on may be excluded.

1400hrs approx First competitive run commences

The finalised timetable will be published in the Competitors' Instructions.

- The length of the course is approximately 1000 yards (914 meters) comprising of tarmac straights and several bends, including two sharp lefts and one sharp right. The average gradient is 1 in 13.6 and the steepest section is at the Martini Hairpin where it is 1 in 6.9.
- 8. The maximum number of entries for this event will be I40 and a call up list, as detailed in the VSCC Speed Championship General Regulations 2018, will be available should this event become oversubscribed.
- 9. In addition to the standard 16 VSCC Classes the following invitation classes will also be accepted:

Class 17 - Post-war Historic Racing Cars, all capacities including F3 500cc Racing Cars built before 01/01/61

Class 18 - Invited 1950's Sports/Racing cars built before 01/01/61

An FIA V5C, HSCC or 500OA Vehicle Identification Form (VIF) document is required for non VSCC cars.

- 10. Awards will be presented as detailed in the VSCC Speed Championship General Regulations.
