#### Marshals' Instructions

Thank you for volunteering to marshal at our Sprint at Goodwood Race Circuit. There are no tickets or car passes for this event.

I. Timings are as follows:

07:15 Signing-on for Signing-on Team and Scrutineers (Jackie Stewart Pavilion)

07:30 – 10:30 Competitors' Signing-on 07:30 Scrutineering starts

08:00Marshals' and Officials' Signing-on09:00Summer Rally Parade commences09:15 – 12:30 (approx.)Practice Sessions commence

12:30 (approx.) – 13:30 Lunch break

13:30 Competitive Runs commence17:00 End of Competitive Runs

- 2. Marshals' allocations are as on the attached sheet, but may be revised according to needs on the day. The Signing-on base will be in the pit lane, behind the Jackie Stewart Pavilion. Radios will be issued to certain personnel.
- 3. There will be a one-hour lunch break at approximately 12:30hrs. The event has always had a large number of spectators and every effort will be made to ensure marshals have priority at the catering units, however, it may be more convenient to bring your own lunches.
- 4. Ensure that you bring protective clothing. Ear protection is available, free of charge, for all marshals at Signing-on.
- 5. Please Note that it is a specific MSA instruction that armbands/tabards must only be issued to persons appointed to act in an official capacity, and that such armbands/tabards are not transferable. The armband/tabard issued to you when you sign-on is for your use in connection with the duty allocated to you only it must not be lent or passed to any other person, or be used for gaining access to any prohibited area.
- 6. Any marshal under the age of 18 must sign-on using an Under 18's signing-on sheet and with parental/guardian consent.
- 7. Motor Sport can be dangerous, and Marshals should stand no nearer to the edge of the track than is absolutely necessary for the performance of their duties and where possible behind the protective barriers.
- 8. If your duty is in an area which is prohibited to the public, please note that you are **not** authorised to allow friends or relations to enter these areas, and you should ask anyone present who is not authorised to be there to leave. Remember that the Club has the use of the site on the understanding that spectators are confined to the paddock and spectator area. The spectator areas are clearly defined at this venue and it is incumbent on all marshals to ensure that no member of the public strays beyond these areas.
- 9. Marshals must not carry cameras if you are off duty and wish to take photographs, for instance during the lunch break, please remove your armband before doing so.

#### 10. ALCOHOL BREATHALYSER TEST

In accordance with D13.1.4, all Drivers and Officials consent to submit themselves to a alcohol breathalyser test as required. The Club approved equipment used for testing are 'AlcoSense Ultra' breathalysers within valid calibration periods of their current calibration certificates. Calibration and maintenance of the devices will be undertaken by AlcoSense Breathalysers. A Driver or Official who is considered to be possibly unfit due to consumption of alcohol will not be permitted to participate. Such persons may request a re-test after a period of at least 60 mins. If the Driver or Official is still considered unfit following the second test he/she remains ineligible to participate. Should a Driver not participate in either qualifying or a race / timed run due to the possibility of being unfit due the consumption of alcohol, further participation shall be at the sole discretion of the Clerk of Course. In addition to the test, the Clerk of the Course and/or the Secretary of the Meeting may, at their sole discretion, direct that a test be carried out on any Driver or Official at any time during the meeting should they consider there are grounds for doing so. The results of all breathalyser tests remain confidential between the Secretary of the Meeting, the Clerk of the Course and the Driver or Official concerned. Refusal or withdrawal of consent to take a breathalyser test will be treated as a failure of the test and the Driver or Official shall be excluded from participation at the meeting.

If you have been randomly selected for a Breathalyser Test it will be indicated on a Bulletin displayed at 0730hrs on the official noticeboard in Race Admin located in the Jackie Stewart Pavilion. Please report to the Secretary of the Meeting before the start of your duty.

11. Please note that camping on the Goodwood Site is not permitted under any circumstances.
