Clothing & Protective Equipment

Marshals should dress appropriately for their duty. Those working trackside, or otherwise closely with competing cars, should note that arms and legs should be covered and High Viz needs to be worn at all times. Please observe the usual standards of behaviour expected of Marshals at Speed events: do not allow friends to enter prohibited areas; do not stand with your back to approaching traffic; do not carry a camera etc. It is the responsibility of all Marshals to ensure that spectators do not get into prohibited areas or onto the track. Please remain at your post until cleared to stand down by the Clerk of the Course or his Deputy. All Marshals should note that ear protection is available from Marshals' Signing-on should they be required.

Marshals with Hill Positions

All Marshals' Posts have shelter. The Controller can talk to all the posts simultaneously by radio. Each post can talk to the Controller via radio. The following routine will be used for both practice and competition. The Hill Controller is in communication with the Marshal appointed at each Marshal Post; they must report immediately any interruption in the progress of any car, stating which car by number and if any assistance is required. The Hill Controller will arrange for the dispatch of Emergency Service Vehicles as required. In the event of any stoppage, incident or obstruction the nearest flagman downhill will show his red flag and blow his whistle. This must be repeated down the hill to the start

It is essential that Hill Marshals watch the passing of each car and if it stops or appears in difficulty the red flag must be displayed at once in order to allow the following car time to stop. When the course is clear, the flagman at the point of origin will withdraw his flag and the remaining flags will then be taken down in order. The reason for the display of the red flag must be reported by radio from the point of origin immediately. REMEMBER; always quote the car competition number and use the words 'Safety' or 'Emergency', which will be covered during the briefings that will take place each morning, please see the timetable above.

- Please be reminded there are no dogs to be on site during the event; in line with other Speed Events this season.
- **Camping is free for Marshals but please make sure you pick up a camping pass, which needs to be displayed on the outside of your unit, at signing on or the Club Van. Camping is available both Friday and Saturday evening. Site access is from 1530hrs on Friday please vacate by 2100hrs on Sunday 9th September.**


