In order to help clarify the regulations, we have created a guide to what is acceptable and what is considered a failure. For each suitcase you cannot carry properly in your car will carry a penalty of 20 marks. All cars must be tested properly at scrutineering and have the cases placed within the car. Spare wheels must be carried whilst undertaking the suitcase test
