I. Many thanks for entering the 2020 Exmoor Trial. You will find enclosed all the information you require to compete on this event.

The Trial this year has hills open all day; Line drawing maps are provided for all hills. Please note that entry to the Redcleave Hills has changed and in 2020 IS NOT from A396 at Milton Bridge.

Entry points for the hills are detailed in this document.

2. Event Timetable

0830-1030hrs Competitor signing-on and scrutineering

3. Arrival at Event and Registration Procedures

The Trial will start and finish at the Anchor Inn, Exebridge, Somerset, TA22 9AZ; OS 181/930244. Please be considerate at the start and finish and adhere to the trailer parking rules: Trailers must not be parked at the Anchor unless you have a room booking. Please leave them at your accommodation or use the pay and display car park opposite the Swan & Bridge in the centre of Bampton. Approach from Tiverton/M5, up main street then bear left, then 100 yards up the hill, take second left signposted for the Trading Estate then left into car park.

Leaving car park, cross the main road beside the Old Plough & head north on what was formerly the B3222 to Exebridge. Petrol is available in Dulverton on B3222 road to/from A396.

7. Competition Licence Requirement - NEW AND MANDATORY FOR 2020

All competitors; Drivers, Navigators, Bouncers, etc. need to have one of the new Motorsport UK RS Clubman Competition Licenses (unless you have a Race or Speed licence for 2020) these are free, mandatory and issued by our governing body. You can apply online at https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/ and we recommend you do so immediately. If you wish to apply using a paper form you can download the form and return by post to Motorsport UK here https://www.motorsportuk.org/wp-content/uploads/2019/11/03_CLUBMAN_FORM.pdf

8. Scrutineering

- You must carry a fire Extinguisher to AFFF standard with a minimum capacity of 1.75 litres which must be securely attached (K3.4 & K3.5) For the 2019/20 trials season fire extinguishers need to be serviced every twenty four months or your extinguisher has a production date on it that is less than twenty four months from that date, it is acceptable.
- You will also require a Motorsport UK compliant Spill Kit.
- Towing points on your car should be marked clearly in red or yellow.
- Your steering wheel must be marked with tape at the top at the straight-ahead position.

Please report to scrutineering in the car park and park as directed. Once your car has been examined by a scrutineer you will be given a 'pass' slip. Take this to the signing-on table in the Anchor Inn where the Driver and <u>all</u> Passengers <u>must present their</u> Motorsport UK Licence and sign-on for the event. You will be issued with your Score Card and competition numbers that you should affix to the front and rear of your car.

Your Start Hill is shown on the enclosed List of Competitors. It is the Competitor's responsibility to ensure their score card is correctly completed at each hill by the Marshals. Scorecards must be returned to the Anchor Inn no later than 5pm, late cards may not be included in the results. If you retire please ask other competitors to inform a Hill Chief or other official.

Centre front wheel marking will be used and all Hill marshals are appointed judges of fact for all decisions regarding the scoring of hills. The front passenger seat must be occupied while attempting each Section. No perching up on the seatback or lying back near horizontal, Blue Book Regulations T4.1.1 and T4.1.11 apply. The number of passengers must be indicated on the score card and not varied throughout the event.

A minimum tyre pressure rule will be applied @7 psi; random checks may be made. You will be asked if your pressures are correctly adjusted prior to climbing a hill; if yes pressure will be checked and if found to be below the minimum requirement a penalty of 25 points will be applied. If no, then you will be asked to adjust and the check will be applied as above. The pressure check will be done using the Club's digital gauges, A check may also be made at the top of a hill.

A roller-type differential test may be used on the event, failing this test will result in exclusion from the event. Always give way to horses, switch off engine if necessary.

9. Stop and Restart

You will be briefed by the Start Marshal; you will then proceed to the restart BOX (within 4 white posts) and stop with your front wheels within the box; after the marshal's signal (raising of flag), you should proceed. If unsuccessful after 10 seconds the marshal will instruct you to stop; if you do not your score will be entered as '0'. You have been warned!! Slight rolling back is allowed, but your front wheels MUST remain in the box, only ONE attempt.




