Questions (and answers)

Section 1:

1. How many steep gradient symbols do you go through?
 - a. 5
2. What's the name of the wood you pass through, north of the road (also famous as a section on the MCC Lands End Trial)?
 - a. Bishop's Wood
3. What national cycle route do you cross?
 - a. 32 (aka the Camel Trail)

Section 2:

1. There are just two words that completely cross the road you follow on this section – what are they?
 - a. Hustyns (GS 9868) and Tumulus (GS 9867)
2. In which village is the campsite? (13 letters)
 - a. Ruthernbridge
3. Around 1 km north of the most westerly part of the route is a blue symbol. What is it?
 - a. Duck/wading bird etc. (actually means 'Nature reserve')

Section 3:

1. How many times do you pass under an ETL?
 - a. 2
2. Which long distance walking route do you travel along for a short distance early in the section?
 - a. Saints Way
3. What river do you cross at the end of the section?
 - a. Camel

Section 4:

1. How many times do you cross grid line 04?
 - a. What is the total of all the spot heights and triangulation points you pass through along the route? $116+23+114+19 = 272$
2. What type of farm do you pass ~1km from the end of the section?
 - a. Solar farm

Section 5:

1. Whose tenement do you pass early in the section?
 - a. Job's Tenement
2. What spot height appears twice along the route?
 - a. 5
3. How many holes are in the cross near where you meet the A39?
 - a. 3
