

Welcome to Sussex, a county that is 2 (East and West) although it also has a Middle. This Sussex confusion was encouraged at the start of WWII, where Sussex humorous sayings to any *furriner* who would listen included "*You can walk to Edinburgh quicker than drive across Sussex by signpost*". Local councils allowed '*Road signage be altered to correctly show routes inappropriate for the mode of travel*'. This was to help confuse the Nazi spies or invaders were they to arrive…and VSCC drivers of course. Today's visitors, and some locals, may say little seems to have changed!

<u>Stage 1</u> – A right Sussex muddle. Not quite CRO – 4 sections of white road – 1km, 1.2km, 0.05km, 0.8km. All white roads bar <u>1</u> are shared with bridleways or footpaths.

Start at Kenwards Farm 342266. Head towards the main road, then follow:

2 red diamonds in white to WYY YYY YWY + YYY YWY - YYYY YWY - YYYY YWY - YYYY

+ (<u>through an end gate</u>) e E 138159 Ĩ ← P P 🖠

Finish 361326 - 90° bend below museum.

Set off from 467312 at 11:30. Stop on the 3<sup>rd</sup> diamond.

Finish and end 434347 place of worship. Park up and head to the village hall for a coager - a local expression for bread, cheese and beer.
