

VSCC Prescott Camping Campsite Rules and Safety

Campsite Rules

- No open fires or braziers.
- BBQs are permitted but must be supervised and kept away from vehicles or tents. Please ensure that BBQs are safely extinguished once they have been used.
- No fireworks of any kind.
- Children and minors must be supervised at all times and must not be left unsupervised on the campsite.
- Please, no electrically amplified music will be permitted this year.
- The use of 'Silent Discos' is not permitted.
- Vehicle movement is to be **minimised** and vehicles should be driven **slowly and with great care**. Pedestrians have right of way at all times.
- Except in case of emergency, there is to be NO vehicle movement, or access or egress from the site between midnight and 7am on Friday and Saturday.
- Fire lanes MUST be kept clear at all times.
- Curfews. The campsite is to be quiet from 1130pm and silent from midnight until 6am. **THIS IS A SAFETY ISSUE – COMPETITORS, OFFICIALS AND MARSHALS NEED THEIR SLEEP.**
- Fuel for competition must not be stored in the campsite.
- Please minimise the amount of rubbish you generate and bag waste before putting it in the skips. In particular ALL FOOD WASTE is to be secured in bags before putting it in the skip. Ensure BBQ debris is COMPLETELY cold.
- Please take all automotive debris away with you and do not leave tyres, broken vehicle components, waste oil etc. Doing so will cause considerable difficulty and cost for the club.
- Please be aware that purchase of a camping pass implies that you will accept responsibility for the behaviour of all the people living on, or visiting, your pitches. In the event of any problems be aware that there are professional security personnel on site whose assistance you can seek.

SAFETY

Fire Precautions

- Ensure that caravans and tents are at least 3 metres apart.
- Acquaint yourself with the location of the nearest fire-fighting equipment.
- Keep a torch handy for emergencies. Do not use a lit candle.
- Fires in tents and caravans can spread extremely quickly. In the event of a fire, get everyone out straight away, warn those nearby and evacuate the area. Call 999 – location postcode is GL52 9RD

Gas Bottles

- Keep cylinders outside and away from tents.
- Check all appliances are turned off before going to bed.
- Turn off all cylinders unless appliances are designed to run continually (eg fridges).
- Change gas cylinders only when they are completely empty and then vent them outside.

Caravans

- Take care when cooking – don't leave lit cookers unattended.
- Do not smoke in caravans, particularly in bed.
- Children **MUST NOT** be left alone in caravans.
- Keep caravans ventilated and ensure air vents are clear.
- Keep a serviceable fire extinguisher in an easily accessible position.

Tents

- Flammable liquids and gas cylinders should be kept and used only outside the tent – and away from children.
- Keep cooking appliances away from anything flammable, including dry grass.
- Do not smoke inside tents

Barbeques

- The use of proprietary BBQs is permitted but:
- Ensure they are **CONSTANTLY** supervised.
- Check they are extinguished and cool before going to bed or leaving unattended.
- **DO NOT** dump embers or ash on the field. Bag them (when cold!) and use the skips provided.
