A	1	Clough Wood	Darley Bridge	See Notes	Approach via MR 119 / 265620. No parking in the quarry. Park on the approach road from Darley Bridge but no farther than the No Parking signs. The track must be kept clear for competitors to enter and exit the quarry. Please walk to the quarry from your parking location.
A	2	Mill Close Mine	Darley Bridge	See Notes	
C	5	Beeley Plantation	Beeley	273676	Please park carefully around the village there is a pleasant ½ mile walk up to the section – Beeley is a sensitive area so care is needed in the village
D	9	Lindop and Russian sections	Calton Lees	256683	Please park in Calton Lees pay Car park and walk in to the sections – again ½ mile walk
E	12	Foret De Perez	Walton	347695	Please enter via the gate at map ref and take the right fork in the wood. You will be travelling against trial traffic and please park safely where you can.
B	3	Wellington	Middleton-by-Youlgreave	193631	Please park in the centre of Middleton or the road up to the hill and walk in - Easy access.
