



VSCC Prescott Speed Hill Climb

Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd August 2026

Competitors, officials, marshals and spectators please have an enjoyable and dry Prescott weekend

The campsite opens at 1300 on Friday 31st July. No arrivals before then; they will cause disruption to the farm and there is no holding area available. The best approach is from the west (Cheltenham and Bishops Cleeve). The postcode is GL52 9RD. What 3 Words for the camping entrance: decking. grills. slap

Do not stop, park, unload or load trailers on the entrance hard standing

Have your wristbands on prior to arrival and keep them on all weekend: they are required for each person over the age of 16. Please do not allow anyone to stay over night without a wristband: it is unfair on the great majority and we need everyone's contribution to the cost of providing the site. More can be bought on the gate for £20, cash only

Drive slowly and with great care. Pedestrians have right of way at all times. These are agricultural fields with an uneven surface and some deep ruts

Cars, vintage and modern, may be parked next to your pitch, but car movements should be kept to a minimum and at low speed

Competition cars which are not road legal may be trailered onto the camping field but must not be driven on the highway to the paddock

Competition numbers must be covered at all times when cars leave the paddock, and this includes the campsite. The club will provide blanking sheets at sign on

Prescott camping is a special and much valued highlight of the club year. We are guests of Prescott village, the BOC, and Mr and Mrs Marsh of Pardon Hill Farm. Please be kind and considerate to each other and to our hosts, volunteers and staff. Please do stick to the few camping rules we have set out which, by purchasing camping passes, you agree you will follow
